 - Y Keyboard Skills are one of the components of the comprehensive piano exams. A student or teacher may choose to test Keyboard Skills as a separate exam.
 - Y A replacement certificate (\$5 fee, payable to MMTA) may be obtained by mailing a request to the MMTA Office along with a copy of the scoresheet.
 - Y A student who is absent from an exam because of illness may, with a doctor's excuse, take the exam at a future testing or apply the fee to another level exam. Notify the Site Administrator if a student is unable to take the exam. Mail the doctor's excuse with the new registration.
 - Y Teachers are requested to volunteer on exam day. For information about available jobs, contact the Site Administrator, or go to www.mnmusicteachers.com.

Awards Certificates are awarded to students who achieve a score of 60% or higher.
