**When can we expect other new editions to be released?**

2023-2024

- Level 6 – 2nd edition (2023) release Jan 2023. Testing begins in the fall of 2023

2024-2025

- Level 7 – 2nd edition (2024) release Jan 2024. Testing begins in the fall of 2024

2025-2026

- Level 8 – 2nd edition (2025) release Jan 2025. Testing begins in the fall of 2025.
