The flute program of MMTA consists of two activities, a contest and education examinations.. The flute contest consists of two tiers - a traditional contest for the ages given below and a Young Artist contest, also described below. The examinations follow a syllabus outlining seven levels, each containing scales and arpeggios, studies, repertoire, sightreading, plus both aural and written theory. Contest winners and students receiving high examination scores receive certificates, performance opportunities, and/or monetary awards. Both of these programs were designed for the use of MMTA teachers but are also open to all teachers of flute.

FLUTE YOUNG ARTIST CONTEST

Repertoire requirements:

Program is not to exceed 25 minutes.

Major work: one movement of a major work for solo instrument with orchestra or wind ensemble. Memorization is required.

At least two additional compositions, each representing different historical style periods. Memorization is optional.
